## **COMMUNITY RESOURCES**

**Alabama Cohosh Collaborative** (Huntsville) — Provides several projects to reduce health disparities in Alabama, including doula support and Mama Circle Huntsville.

**Huntsville Postpartum Support Network** (Huntsville) – A private Facebook page providing peer-to-peer support in the Tennessee Valley.

Home Visiting Collaborative Improvement and Innovation Network — Alabama is one of four states participating in this initiative, which brings together federally-funded Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting Programs and local implementing agencies to develop, test, and implement specific interventions. The goal for maternal depression is that 85% of women who screen positive for depression and access services will report a 25% reduction in symptoms within 12 weeks from first service contact.

**The MAMA Collaborative - Maternity and Motherhood in Alabama** (Facebook) — Non-partisan group of mothers networking to take action to make Alabama a better place for moms to give birth, work, and live.
