

#### ONE Health Ohio, Baby on Board Program (Northeastern Ohio)


Provides specialised counseling in maternal mental health and maternal addiction.

# The Gur Laboratory at Ohio State University (Columbus) – Maternal Stress & Microbiome Study

Through this longitudinal observational study, the aim is to improve and better understand how maternal stress experienced during pregnancy impacts psychological, gestational, and microbial outcomes in mom and baby.
